\$999 per person

Our \$999 per person performance fee includes:

- 1. COMPLETE AND PROFESSIONAL ARTISTIC DEVELOPMENT AND ADMINISTRATION of your performance** in New York City, including: venue, labor and personnel at the hall, including ushers, stage crew, house managers, etc.; official *Playbill* preparation and printing; publicity and audience development (flyers, posters, press releases, etc.); schedules; protocols; backstage management; security passes; and day-to-day concert- and residency-related matters in the months leading up to your performance. In addition, MidAmerica provides assistance with pre-concert preparation, including pre-concert recording evaluations and coordination of instrumental rental, if necessary. During the five-day residency itself, **MidAmerica staff members are personally on-site to manage all concert-related activities.**
- 2. An exclusive POST-CONCERT CELEBRATION RECEPTION CRUISE** on-board the Spirit of New York or Spirit of New Jersey (or similar). All concert-only package performers and non-performers are provided a two-hour sail featuring a spectacular view of the Statue of Liberty and the Manha[an skyline, with a buffet dinner, music, and dancing. Two drink tickets will also be provided; extra drinks can be purchased on board. *(MidAmerica can also provide post concert round-trip bus transportation from the concert hall to Chelsea Piers and back to the residency hotel upon your request for an additional \$49 per person. The reason this is not included is because some ensembles bring their own buses from their home locations to NYC or choose to take taxis or subways.)* [A limited number of guests may also be accommodated for an additional \$179 per person – please contact the MidAmerica production office for details regarding additional cruise tickets and their availability for non-residency guests.] Cruise guests must be 21 years of age or older to consume alcoholic beverages and this is strictly enforced by the cruise line.
- 3. TWO (2) REHEARSALS** prior to the rehearsal and concert in Stern Auditorium / Perelman Stage in Carnegie Hall, scheduled by MidAmerica Productions in another location in Manhattan.
- 4. ONE FREE CONCERT-ONLY PACKAGE** is provided after every thirty (30) paying performer registrants. (See page 11).
- 5. Each Concert-Only Residency Package participant will receive an 8 ½ x 11” PRINT OF THE GIANT MARQUEE POSTER** that announces your concert in Stern Auditorium / Perelman Stage at Carnegie Hall.
- 6. TWO (2) COMPLIMENTARY CONCERT TICKETS** (Parquet seating) for directors with a minimum of 30 registered performers, for their personal use (\$250 value).

IMPORTANT: A minimum of **50 registered** performers is necessary for a performance on this MidAmerica Productions season.

The Non-Performer Package includes:

- 1) Attendance at all rehearsals – including the closed dress rehearsal in Stern Auditorium / Perelman Stage at Carnegie Hall
- 2) One concert ticket (\$125 value – Parquet/Main level) to your performance
- 3) Posters as described above
- 4) An admission ticket for the post-concert cruise as described above (including dinner and two drink tickets)

Please note the above non-performer rate is only available to persons affiliated with ensembles that opt for the \$999 concert-only package.

In determining if registering ensembles qualify for complimentary packages or a group credit, registrants taking the \$499 non-performer package are not counted.

CONCERT TICKETS:

Tickets for each of our 2024, 41st season concerts in Stern Auditorium / Perelman Stage at Carnegie Hall will be available approximately 90 days prior to the concert date through our Andrea Niederman, Director of Public Relations, Publications and Audience Development. ADDITIONAL IMPORTANT INFORMATION

1. At the time of the initial deposit, ensembles will inform MidAmerica whether they elect the “Full Residency” (\$1599 package) or “Concert-Only” (\$999 package for bands/orchestras). These two package options are on a “whole -group” basis, meaning that all participants in the ensemble must choose to take either the Full Residency package , OR the Concert-Only package. Once deposited there can be no changing between “Full Residency” and “Concert-Only” status after, nor any individual exceptions within the registered ensembles. Affiliated non-performers and chaperones who plan to officially register as such with their group must take the same package option as their ensemble.
2. Ensembles consisting of high school-aged performers require at least one registered adult for every 10 students.
3. **DO NOT** purchase any air tickets without getting approved from Ms. Joyce Howard-Brazel, Chief of Account Operations for MidAmerica Productions.
4. MidAmerica encourages participants to take advantage of New York’s unparalleled cultural life. However, until you have received the confirmed rehearsal schedule from MidAmerica Productions, please do not book any non-refundable tickets for any activities (shows, tours, etc.). MidAmerica cannot be responsible for schedule conflicts or losses arising from pre-booking such tickets. Generally, evenings are free during the residency; these are the best times to book Broadway show tickets (except on the concert day). You are welcome to contact Lina DiCarlo at Twin Travel Concepts (lina@twintravelconcepts.com / 917-865-3277) for Broadway show tickets and other entertainment. Ms. DiCarlo has offered this service to our ensembles for 25 years.
5. Ensembles must submit their self arranged travel and lodging particulars to MidAmerica Productions 90 days in advance of their performances. This information should include the groups’ travel specifics (dates, times, and lodging information.)
6. Visiting instrumental ensembles are responsible for bringing or renting their own instruments. Estimated costs for such rentals in Manhattan can be provided by our office as we regularly contact Manhattan Percussion, Inc. If more than one instrumental ensemble is performing at your concert, the rental cost can be divided equally.

The Concert-Only Residency Package Price quoted is fixed and firm.

Only two conditions can affect this package price:

- If at any time, the state of New York or city of New York levies an additional visitors' tax, this tax, upon presentation of documentation, will become the responsibility of the incoming ensemble and will be added to the residency package cost for final payment.
- When a group does not adhere to the published payment deadlines (late penalties can be assessed);

MidAmerica Productions Inc. and MidAm International, Inc. shall not be liable to any individual registrant or group for any injuries, losses, or expenses suffered or incurred by any individual registrant or group arising out of or relating to your purchase of this package. All registrants and groups shall maintain appropriate and adequate general liability insurance coverage and any workmen’s compensation insurance required by applicable state law.

GENERAL RESIDENCY SCHEDULE

The following is a summary of a typical New York residency with MidAmerica Productions. (Which is subject to revision up to 30 days prior to arrival.)

DAY 1:

Arrival in NYC.

DAY 2:

One rehearsal during the morning (or afternoon) in Manhattan, coordinated by MidAmerica Productions. Ensembles are responsible for their own round-trip transportation to the rehearsal site in this concert-only package.

DAY 3:

An optional rehearsal in the morning (or afternoon). The evening is free.

DAY 4:

Final dress rehearsal in Stern Auditorium / Perelman Stage at Carnegie Hall; concert*; and post-concert cruise around the Statue of Liberty and lower Manhattan with music, dancing, dinner, and two drinks provided*.

DAY 5:

Departure

CONCERT DRESS: THAT WHICH YOU WEAR IN YOUR HOME LOCATION

THIS IS A SAMPLE ITINERARY. SPECIFIC EVENT TIMES DURING YOUR RESIDENCY WILL BE ANNOUNCED 90-100 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR ARRIVAL.

**Your performance features your instrumental ensemble, under your direction, in a performance consisting of 25 minutes of music time, which equates to 30 minutes of stage time, allowing for applause, change of music, and tuning, based on a minimum ensemble of 50-69 performers. Ensembles of 70 or more performers are provided 40 minutes of stage time and 35 minutes of music time.*

***Transportation to and from the post-concert cruise is not included in the Concert-Only package.*

ALL DEPOSITS ARE NON-REFUNDABLE WHEN RECEIVED AND THIS APPLIES TO ANY INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP WHO HAS MADE ANY PAYMENTS. In addition, should an individual cancel participation, deposits are non-transferable to the group's unpaid balance (substitutions for cancelled persons are permissible). Cancellation insurance, therefore, is strongly recommended. Please visit www.travelexinsurance.com or call 1-800-228-9792 to inquire about trip cancellation insurance. If the specified hall is unavailable for your performance due to "acts of God" (force majeure), MidAmerica Productions, Inc., reserves the right to move this concert to another concert location within New York City or to reschedule it to the following year. Acts of God (force majeure) shall include any unexpected act or circumstance that prevents or impedes MAP from performing one or more of its contractual obligations if such impediment to MAP's performance is beyond MAP's reasonable control and the effects of such impediment cannot reasonably have been avoided or overcome by MAP. For purposes of this provision, Acts of God shall include, but are not limited to: a) war (whether declared or not), hostilities, act of foreign enemies, b) civil war, riot, rebellion and revolution, act of terrorism, sabotage or piracy; c) currency and trade restriction, embargo, sanction; d) act of authority whether lawful or unlawful, compliance with any law or governmental order, expropriation, seizure of works, requisition, nationalization; e) plague, epidemic (including continuation of COVID-19 pandemic into or beyond 2024), natural disaster or extreme natural event; f) explosion, fire, destruction of equipment, prolonged break-down of transport, telecommunication, information system or energy; g) and general labor disturbance. It is the responsibility of all persons participating as performers to arrive on time and be fully prepared for all rehearsals as well as the performance.

All participants in the package must undertake at their own expense to comply with all dress and health requirements of governmental entities as well as the venues where the performance and other events are being held. Should these parameters not be met, MidAmerica retains the right to disallow those individuals from participating in the rehearsal and/or performance. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the State of New York, without regard to the conflicts of law principles thereof. The parties consent to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts within the County and State of New York with respect to any dispute arising out of this agreement.

INITIAL PAYMENT DEADLINES AND COMPLIMENTARY PACKAGES FOR STERN AUDITORIUM / PERELMAN STAGE AT CARNEGIE HALL 2023-24

- A credit of one package (\$999) is applied after **30** performer packages purchased by the **standard** registration deadline with an initial deposit of \$300 per person. (#31 is complimentary.)
- An **additional** package credit (\$999) is applied after **30** performer packages purchased by the **early** registration deadline with an initial deposit of \$300 per person.

Terms and conditions:

- Group directors must indicate at the time of registration whether they will be participating as a Performer, Non-performer, or guest conductor. Directors are not included in a group's tally if they are guest conductors, as their accommodations are handled separately.
- Credits only apply to group registrations; individual registrations through the MAP website do not count towards a tally for complimentary packages.
- Complimentary packages may be used for an individual (director, accompanist, etc.) or may be applied toward the group's balance to reduce each participant's cost. All credits will be applied on the group's final invoice.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS **FOR INSTRUMENTAL ENSEMBLES**

1. How are ensembles selected for and invited to participate in this concert series?

Each ensemble has been specifically recommended or referred to us. Additionally, ensembles can also be accepted after submitting an audition CD, video, or YouTube link to the General Music Director.

2. When will we know the schedule for our residency in New York?

Schedules (and rehearsal locations) are published 2-3 months in advance of your concert date. Typically, however, on the first, second and third nights of your residency you are free to do as you wish. Please refer to the general residency schedule on page 8 for more information.

3. Where can percussion and large instruments be rented in NYC?

Please contact Norman Dunfee, Production Manager, at ndunfee@midamerica-music.com for more information about percussion and instrument rentals.

4. What size audience can we expect at our concert?

Audiences are large and enthusiastic. MidAmerica Productions has a comprehensive public relations and audience development division headed by Andrea Niederman, Director of Public Relations, Publications and Audience Development.

5. How are the concerts advertised?

Concerts are promoted extensively through local press and social media, along with hundreds of public and private business sources in the New York and tri-state area as well as a mailing list of over 25,000 names. This coverage, as well as efforts for press coverage in ensembles' home locations are led by Andrea Niederman, our Director of Public Relations, Publications, and Audience Development.

6. May friends and family also attend the post-concert dinner cruise?
